He returned to Malaysia in 1985 with a degree in agricultural science and a PhD in agricultural economics to begin life as an academic with University Pertanian Malaysia (now University Putra Malaysia) and later as a senior researcher with the Institute of Strategic and International Studies (ISIS).

In 1987 he joined the Sabah Institute of Development Studies as Associate Director and rose up to hold the position of Executive Director cum Chief Executive of the organization in 1991.

He left in 1994 to enter the topsy-turvy world of politics building a strong reputation where his innate patience, integrity and loyalty continue to endear him to his electorate as well as those who work with him. Testimony to the high regard that the current government leadership has for him is his recent selection as Chairman of the Parliamentary Select Committee on Electoral Reform.
