The programme has since widened to include gifted and talented children through the establishment of Permata Pintar and Permata Seni. The spiritual aspect is addressed through Permata Insan.

Today Permata centres can be found all across the nation, creating a wave of change through human capital that will strengthen the nation as it evolves and faces daunting challenges from within the country and beyond.
